Coffee Talks with the Administrative Team

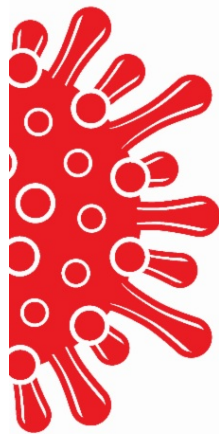
