**DISTRICT GRADING POLICY DURING
THE SCHOOL CLOSURE** | No matter the circumstances, please know that all of us in the Cuyahoga Heights Schools remain committed to delivering a quality education to your student during the COVID-19 crisis.

Please understand that every school district is assessing student work in a way they deem most productive for their students and school district. In Cuyahoga Heights, we will continue to assess the work your student is completing. At the Elementary School, our focus will be on mastery of learning objectives. At the Middle/High School we will continue to assess work in an effort to determine grades, and therefore credit toward graduation. Be on the lookout for specifics from your child's principal.

In addition, we are exploring dates for senior activities should the school closure extend beyond the end of the school year. We have secured dates at the end of June in an attempt to conduct as many senior activities as possible, in the hopes we have the "all clear" by then. If not, we will explore opportunities later in the summer to conduct as many senior year activities as possible. But please try to be patient. We can only make these plans if the Governor has deemed it safe to lift stay-at-home and social distancing restrictions by then.
