**BUILDING HOURS FOR THE WEEK OF MARCH 30** | We have had several requests to temporarily open buildings so that students may access items that remain in their lockers, pick up medications, or pick up/turn in specific assignments. As a result we will open the buildings on a limited, controlled basis next week. Here are the details:

- Buildings will be opened on TUESDAY, March 31st and THURSDAY, April 2nd, from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm.
- Social distancing practices will be followed, including maintaining 6 ft between all individuals, with hand sanitizer being available throughout our facilities.

- Elementary students will enter the building at the entrance nearest the office doors.
- Middle/High School students will enter through the pillar doors in the front of the building.
- If teachers are requesting that you drop-off or pick-up materials, that will take place in the gymnasiums, the same as the first time pickup.

Thank you for following these procedures to keep our school community safe at this critical time.
