### Return to School Beginning October 19

As statistics from the Ohio Department of Health continue to show favorable data trends, we are refining our Tentative Re-Entry Plan to bring students back into our buildings. At this time, we intend to bring students back on Monday, October 19 in a Scarlet & Gray (A/B) Hybrid Model at 50% capacity. With this hybrid model, we are able to socially distance in classrooms, hallways, lunches and other common areas while effectively implementing other safety protocols. Whether participating in the hybrid or remote model, our goal is for students, as closely as possible, to follow their normal schedules just as they would when we are fully in session. Please understand that plans are subject to change based on a variety of health and safety factors.

Here are some specifics to the schedule for students:

#### **Scarlet Cohort**

Learn at school in-person on Monday and Thursday following schedule  
Learn from home on Zoom on Tuesday and Friday following schedule and taught by their CHS teachers  
HEIGHTS Day on Wednesday from home

#### **Gray Cohort**

Learn at school in-person on Tuesday and Friday following schedule  
Learn from home on Zoom on Monday and Thursday following schedule and taught by their CHS teachers  
HEIGHTS Day on Wednesday from home

**Remote Cohort** (those families opting for their students to continue with 100% Remote)

Learn at home on Zoom on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday following schedule and taught by their CHS teachers  
HEIGHTS Day on Wednesday from home

In addition, for those families currently participating in our Off-Site Learning Center program, this service will continue to be available to you when your student is not in school. Adjustments will be made and more information is to come for these families.

We will notify families in the near future to which cohort students are assigned. With this model in mind, we ask that you complete this short survey so that we can 1) determine which students will opt to participate in the Scarlet & Gray Hybrid or remain in remote learning beginning October 19; and 2) determine which students will use school transportation when we return to in-person learning using the Scarlet & Gray Hybrid.

**This 2-question survey will be available between 12:00 p.m. on October 2 and 11:59 p.m. on October 6. Please note, this must be completed for each child.**
