CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19
WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

The Cuyahoga County Board of Health requires school districts to report and contact trace known positive cases among staff and students even when our schools are engaged in remote learning.

Reported during Holiday Break:

- **QUARANTINE:** Students (30) | Staff (6)
- **POSITIVE TEST:** Students (1) | Staff (3)

What you should know right now:

- Primary contacts through extra-curricular activities do not change under the new guidance shared by the Governor.
- If you test for COVID-19 you are to be quarantined until you receive results of that test, regardless of how long it takes to receive the results.
- Although we have been on a holiday break and will return in remote learning, we are still required to report our numbers to the County Department of Health.
