PFIZER COVID VACCINE CLINIC PARTNERSHIPS FOR STUDENTS AGES 16 & OLDER

I'm pleased to share that Cuyahoga Heights Schools will be partnering with Independence and Brecksville-Broadview Heights school districts to make COVID Vaccines available to our students ages 16 and older. Here's what you need to know:

- Vaccinations are **VOLUNTARY**.
- All health information will be kept strictly confidential by our school district and Akron Children's Hospital.
- Vaccinations will be administered by Akron Children's Hospital nursing staff.
- Students will receive the Pfizer vaccine. [Please review the attached information sheet from the CDC about the Pfizer vaccine.](#)
- This is a two-dose vaccine, scheduled 3 weeks apart.
 - **SHOT #1:** The first vaccination clinic will take place in the morning at Independence High School **next Friday, April 23rd.**
 - **SHOT #2:** The second vaccine will be delivered three weeks later, same location and time, on **Friday May 14th.**
- Parents will **not** be able to accompany their child to the vaccine clinic.
- All physical distancing and COVID safety protocols will be followed.
- Students should wear tops that allow easy access to their shoulder for vaccination. Short sleeved shirts are recommended.
- Parents are encouraged to visit akronchildrens.org for more information about COVID-19 and frequently asked questions.
